# WRRDA-Reform


- #1) Get rid of the existing project backload **Section 6001** 
  - -Deauthorization of \$18B backlog
    - Not constructed or funding in last 7 years
- #2) Prevent additional project backload
  - a. Deauthorization of new projects not funded for construction within 7 years
    - Section 6003
  - b. <u>Faster/Cheaper</u>: Start only studies that can be funded seamlessly and complete them in 3 years
    - Section 1001 Made 3x3 law
    - Section 1002 No recon phase
    - **Section 1003** Move directly into design after Chiefs Report





# Hurricane and Storm Damage Reduction Projects -Extension of Project Life

Section 1037: 3 year, 15 year



## Storm Response and Resiliency

**Section 1011** – Priority for studies recommended in a Comprehensive Hurricane Study

- Priority for studies involving imminent threat to life safety and infrastructure

**Section 3029** – Authority to construct full design template during storm response

- also provides authority to modify project during emergency construction to address deficiencies





## Regional Sediment Management

**Section 1038 -** Encourages study and use of RSM principles to save cost

**Section 1030 -** Increases threshold of RSM Continuing authority projects

## Harbor Maintenance Trust Fund

**Section 2101 -** Increase Navigation maintenance funds over time

- Improved economics at Ports
- More RSM sediments available for beaches



...and much much more including many provisions allowing non-Federal sponsors to conduct studies/projects or to fund projects/studies.
